Active Shooter/Hostile Events Awareness Level Training

Due to the recent events that have happened across our nation, State Fire Rescue Training through the fire commission, will be conducting <u>awareness level training</u> on <u>active shooter incidents</u>. This course is approximately 3 hours and is designed to create awareness and stimulate discussion.

Topics of discussion in the class will include:

- 1. Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) principles and practices.
- 2. Pre-incident planning and establishing SOPS's.
- 3. Best response principles and practices.
- 4. TECC Skills used in active shooter events.
- 5. Techniques for casualty evacuation during active shooter events.

This program is **not** designed to make everyone a law enforcement officer, but is designed to illustrate a standard practice for response to incidents involving Active shooters for all disciplines.

Participants will be awarded Firefighter Training Credits in *X-0000, Emergency & Disaster Planning* and will also qualify for EMS Continuing Education training credit.

The target audience includes EMS responders, Fire Departments, Emergency Management, Law Enforcement agencies, School Administration and SRO's, and Administrators of Places of Worship.
